CODY HEIN *Camp Director*

Cody Hein recently completed his fifth season as the head coach of the Chico State women's volleyball team. Last fall, Hein led the Wildcats to a 16-13 record and the squad's second consecutive trip to the NCAA Pacific Region playoffs. In his five seasons at Chico State, Hein's players have earned three All-America awards, five All-Pacific Region awards and eleven All-California Collegiate Athletic Association awards.

A California native, Hein came to Chico State from Florida Tech where he ran a very successful program for three years.

Prior to Florida Tech, Hein was the first assistant at Barry University from 1997-2000. The Buccaneers reached the NCAA Division II playoffs all three years he was there, including the national championship match in 1997. Before Hein moved to Miami, he was the assistant coach for the UC Berkeley men's volleyball program from 1995-97.

Hein played collegiate ball at UC Berkeley. There, he was part of three Collegiate Club National Championship teams in four seasons.



GENERAL CAMP INFO

To Enroll

Fill out the attached enrollment form and mail it in with a \$50 deposit for each camp attending. Full camp fees are required with the enrollment form if signing up after May 31, 2008. All campers must have health insurance coverage and have had a physical exam within the past year. A confirmation packet that includes a detailed itinerary, medical history form, photo release form, and camper rules will be mailed upon receipt of your enrollment. To Cancel a Camp

You may cancel a camp prior to June 1, 2008 and receive a refund of all camp fees minus a \$25 administrative fee. There will be no refunds for camps cancelled after June 1, 2008.

Absence from Camp

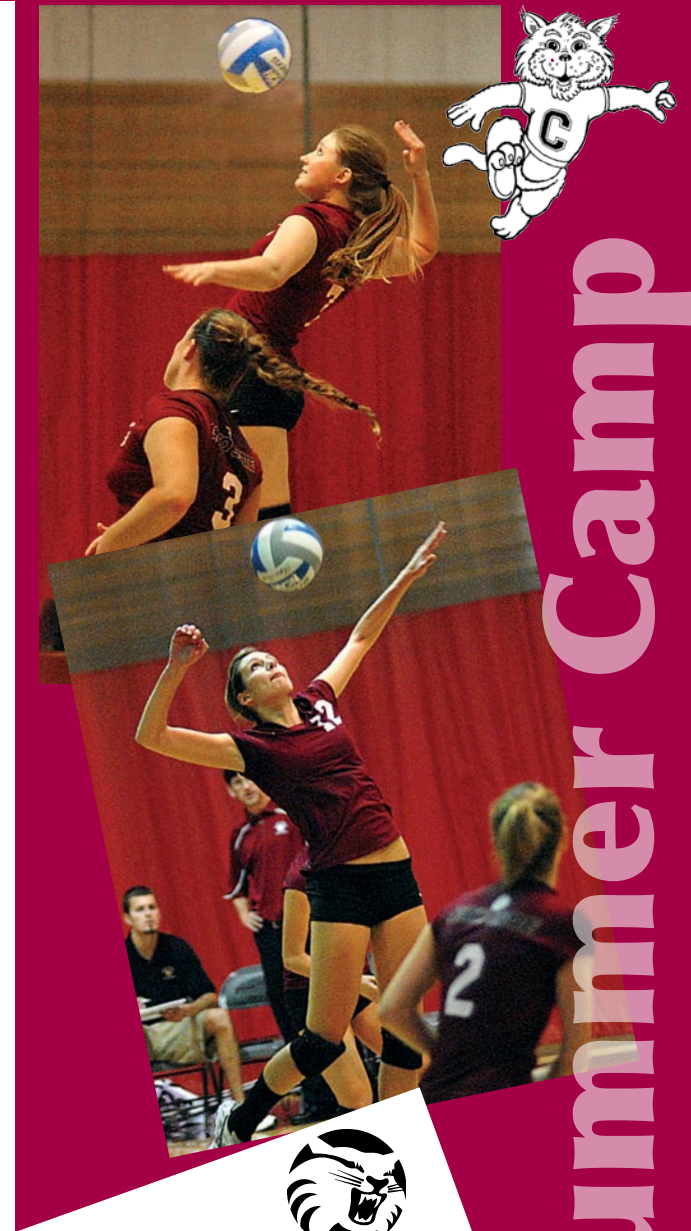
Any days missed from camp will not be deducted, returned or pro-rated from the camp fee.

Illness or Injury

If a child suffers a minor injury during any camp, he/she will receive first aid from the camp staff. A written accident/incident report will be given to the parent during pick up. Parents, or emergency contacts listed on the child's health form, will be notified immediately in the event of serious illness or injury— this includes any injury to the head. A child with a body temperature of 100 degrees or higher will need to be picked up from camp. If necessary, an injured child will be transported to an appropriate medical facility (Enloe Hospital unless otherwise stated on health form.)

Health Insurance and Release Form

Medical coverage is necessary for participation in any Chico State Sports Camp. A signed and returned release form is required for participation.

YOUTH SKILLS CAMP

June 9-12, 2008

The Youth Skills Camp will introduce athletes to the sport of volleyball. The focus is on providing a positive environment for learning and sharing on and off the volleyball court. A variety of drills, games and competitions will be used to complete the understanding of each skill. The intent is for the camper to obtain a good feeling for all the basic components of the game of volleyball. Current Chico State players and coaches will provide instruction.

COST: \$125

CAMP HOURS

The Youth Skills Camp is a half-day camp running from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. Campers should be dropped off no later than 1:45 PM, and picked up between 5:00 - 5:30 PM. The camp will provide supervised open gym until 5:30 PM for those parents who cannot pick their child up until after 5:00 PM.

ADVANCED Jr. HIGH/HIGH SCHOOL CAMP

July 7-10, 2008

The Junior High School/High School Camp is designed for the volleyball player, ages 13-18, who is preparing for the upcoming season. The camp offers the opportunity to explore new techniques for learning the fundamental volleyball skills. The mornings and afternoons will emphasize individual and team skills and how to incorporate them into overall team play. The evenings will be primarily six-on-six team play through various games and tournaments. With great instruction and good competition, the camper should depart camp with a new found confidence in her game.

COST: \$375 overnight - includes three meals and lodging in campus residence hall.

\$300 extended day - includes lunch and dinner.
